

Camp Lakotah

Camp Rules

Please read through the following facility rules with your participants prior to arriving. By signing the Use Agreement Terms & Conditions, the group agrees to abide by these rules at all times during their stay:

1. To prevent the spread of insects and disease to our forest, do not bring firewood from home. All firewood must be obtained in the Wautoma area or from Camp Lakotah. (Scrap cutoffs of dimensional/construction lumber permitted).
2. Smoking is **not permitted in any camp buildings**. Smoking is only permitted in designated outdoor areas. Any evidence of indoor smoking (ashes, order, butts, etc...) will result in a \$50.00/room cleaning fee.
3. Camp Lakotah's quiet hours are **10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.** These hours will be strictly enforced in respect of our neighbors.
4. Possession of alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs is prohibited. Any evidence of alcoholic beverages (cans, bottles, intoxication, etc...) will result in a \$50.00 cleaning fee, and expulsion from the Camp premises.
5. Help keep wildlife in the forest, do not bring food or candy into sleeping areas or cabins.
6. For your safety and to prevent damage to camp property, we ask that you do not move beds, furniture, or storage cabinets. (Damage will be assessed accordingly).
7. Fireworks, explosives, ammunition, and firearms are prohibited.
8. The use of bicycles, ATVs, snowmobiles, and personal watercraft is prohibited without prior arrangement with the Camp Director.
9. Vehicles are to be parked in designated areas and are not used on the grounds at any time. When entering camp, please abide by the **10 MPH** speed limit and stay on the road at all times.
10. Pets are not permitted on camp premises without prior permission of the Camp Director.
11. All waterfront activities must be under the direct supervision of a camp employed lifeguard.
12. All target sport, paintball, and laser tag activities must be under the direct supervision of a camp staff member.
13. Hunting and trapping is prohibited. Cleaning of fish and disposal of entails in designated area only.
14. All emergencies and accidents need to be reported to the camp staff immediately.
15. Picking of flowers or any removal of natural materials from the site is prohibited.
16. When hiking stay on designated trails. Due to the size of Camp Lakotah it is advisable to only hike in groups of two or more.
17. Please place all litter in trash containers.
18. Use of power equipment and tools is prohibited at all times.
19. Cleaning and general housekeeping is the responsibility of the group both during their stay and before departing. A charge will be assessed for damages, as well as excessive clean-up.
20. Tent and RV camping is prohibited unless approved by the Camp Director.
21. Outside fire-building is restricted to established fire pits only. For your safety we ask that you do not use flammable liquids of any kind to ignite indoor or outdoor fires. Fires constructed outside of designated fire pits will result in a fine.
